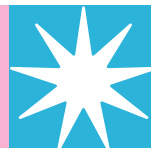
Great work still ahead as Facilitator takes over program

Recruitment of Program Participants

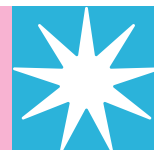
